Come learn how to make Mel's Mix (formulated by Mel Bartholomew in his book Square Foot Gardening) and seed balls in the style of Masanobu Fukuoka (One Straw Revolution). We will be using a Soil Cube (<http://www.soilcube.com/>) to make soil starting cubes as well as experimenting with other non-traditional seed starting containers.



Directions: From Leavenworth, go west on HWY 95/Spruce Ave/ Springdale Rd. Turn right on 195th St, 5.1 miles past the Casey 's General Store at the corner of Spruce and 20th St. If you pass Hamm Quarry you went just too far. Ours is the third drive on the right.
